The town of Opava lies in the western part of Moravian – Silesian Region and with the population of approximately 60,000 inhabitants it is, after Ostrava, one of the largest towns in the region. The town has recently become a cultural, industrial and business centre of the region.

Both modernised and brand new establishments and buildings follow the traditional food-processing, pharmaceutical, paper-making and printing production. Machine works produce mining machinery, components for automotive industry, hydraulic means, industrial fittings, finish hardware, steel works, commercial vehicle bodies and many other things. Many vocational schools are settled in the town, including The Silesian University. The standard of agricultural high school in particular ranks it at the top positions among similar schools in the republic.



Modern agriculture is developing in the surrounding of Opava.

There are many agricultural plants, agricultural machinery manufacturers or sellers of the latest agricultural equipment in the region. The region is a renowned tourist area as well, with many historical residences, technical monuments and crafts traditions. On the north, the region borders with Poland and is a sheer heaven for all big-eyed souls. Unique gastronomy is worth mentioning, too. Among the finest objects are chateaus Kravaře, Raduň, Hradec nad Moravicí, Silesian Museum in Opava, water reservoir Kružberk or Czechoslovak fortification Hlučín - Darkovičky. In the region, you can see many other places well worth visiting.
